You need not be a major or minor in French to apply for membership.

Founded at the University of California in 1906, Pi Delta Phi is among the oldest French honor societies in the United States. The University of Miami is host to the Beta Gamma chapter of the society.

Pi Delta Phi's membership includes students, teachers, and professors, and of course alumni who remain involved with the society. Joining the society brings several advantages: you become a member of a national society with members across the United States; it is an asset on your résumé or curriculum vitae; and summer scholarships are available to undergraduates; graduating students may also order the Pi Delta Phi Honor Cord on their regalia.
